## ARTICLE 13: AMENDMENTS TO THE CONSITUTION AND BY-LAWS

13.1 Amendments to the BMHA Constitution and Bylaws may only be made at the Annual General meeting of the BMHA.

13.2 All proposals for amendments to the Constitution or Bylaws of the BMHA shall be submitted in writing to the BMHA Secretary a minimum of Sixty (60) days prior to the AGM. Individuals submitting amendments must attend or assign a designate to attend on their behalf, at the AGM to speak to the proposed amendment.

If a response is made, it shall be circulated with the notice of motion. Approval of such a motion shall require a two-thirds (2/3) majority in a ballot conducted at the meeting. The Members concerned shall be invited to attend the meeting and to explain their position<del>s</del> before the vote is taken.
