Any motion or new business to be presented at the AGM must be submitted in writing, at least 15 days prior to the date of the AGM, and must be proposed and seconded by a member of the SMHA. Should the member wish to be heard again in rebuttal to any previous speaker, he/she/ must do so through the Chair.
