NOTICE TO ALL BROCK FACILITY USERS and MANDATORY VACCINATION

As legislated by the Ontario provincial government under O. Reg 645/21, and as per Section 2.1 of the Regulation, businesses and organizations "shall require each patron who enters an area of the premises of the business or organization to provide at the point of entry, proof of identification and of being fully vaccinated against COVID-19"

The Township of Brock is following the mandates as set out by the Provincial Government and will be requiring mandatory screening, proof of vaccination, identification, and contact information upon entrance of any municipal facilities.

Entry to facilities will be granted when the patron has shown:

- 1) proof of identification
 - drivers' licence,
 - photo health card,
 - passport

and

- 2) proof of full vaccination
 - An Ontario vaccination receipt from a vaccine clinic when you received your dose (paper copy)
 - A vaccination receipt signed by an Indigenous Health Provider
 - An Ontario Ministry of Health vaccination receipt received by email following your appointment (digital or printed paper copy)
 - <u>Downloaded vaccination receipt</u> from Ontario's <u>provincial booking portal</u> or by calling the Provincial Vaccine Contact Centre at 1-833-943-3900 (digital or printed paper copy)
 - A vaccination receipt from another jurisdiction that shows the holder is fully vaccinated against COVID-19.

As per Section (6) of the Reopening Ontario Act, exemptions apply to patrons:

- (a) who are under 12 years of age;
- (b) who are under 18 years of age, and who are entering the indoor premises of a facility used for sports and recreational fitness activities solely for the purpose of actively participating in an organized sport, in accordance with guidance published by the Ministry of Health on its website for the purposes of this provision;
- (c) who provide a written document, completed and supplied by a physician or registered nurse in the extended class, that sets out, in accordance with the Ministry's guidance mentioned in subsection (4),
 - (i) a documented medical reason for not being fully vaccinated against COVID-19, and
 - (ii) the effective time-period for the medical reason;

Any patron between the ages of 12 and 17 entering the facility as a spectator must provide proof of vaccination.

NOTE: This mandatory Provincial Order is required to be enforced by the Township of Brock and we request that all user groups & patrons have compassion and patience with Township staff at each entrance who will be requesting the necessary information and documentation.

The Township reserves the right to cancel any permitted use at any Township of Brock owned facility.
